MSJC CAMPUS SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS SINCE 2024

- Campus Safety has increased the number of cameras and visibility by over 40% within the last year.
- Developed in conjunction with I.T. fresh service requests for keys, alarm codes, access control, and a campus safety officer for event(s),
- Campus Safety Officers provide dispatch services and monitor all MSJC campuses 24/7.
- A Campus Safety Operations Center is operational at the Temecula Campus.
- Increased overnight staffing for the purpose of monitoring all campuses.
- Campus Safety has increased the available radios which enables accessibility to administrators during emergency situations.
- Parking Permits are now be available via an app (lparq) for students, employees, and the public.
- Trained Safety Staff in CPR.
- Trained Safety Staff in De Escalation.
- Trained Safety Staff in Diversity.
- Review of Training Manual for Campus Safety Officers.
- Review Departmental policy and procedures for Campus Safety updated 2025.
- Created standing Campus Safety Officer post orders for each Campus.



MSJC CAMPUS SAFETY PLANNED ACTIONS

- Continued Camera upgrades and increased coverage throughout all campuses
- Work with Stakeholders (Riverside Sheriff's Office, Risk Management, and Compliance Officer to devise ongoing safety drills.)
- Ongoing planned safety drills in conjunction with designated building captains and area commanders.
- Ongoing Training in De Escalation, CPR, and Diversity
- Ongoing compliance with SB1626.
- Establish an emergency operations coordinator position.
