

Introduction

We invite you to join us in shaping the future of education and workforce development in Southwest Riverside County through Mt. San Jacinto College's (MSJC) new initiative. The Foundation's Naming Rights Initiative offers a unique opportunity for individuals and organizations to make a lasting impact on our campuses, the lives of our students, and the communities we serve.

MSJC is one of only a small number of the 116 California Community Colleges that have fully rebounded from the pandemic from the standpoint of student enrollment and graduation. The entire economic and social ecosystem within the College's 1,700-square-mile district, which is home to more than one million permanent residents, benefits from this success as the need for a more skilled labor force has been growing along with the population and the economic output.

The purpose of this document is to provide essential background information on MSJC and our naming rights initiative, highlighting the critical need for support from the local community in Southwest Riverside County. Without operational support for our new facilities, MSJC will struggle to meet the increasing demand for qualified workers in most of the important growth sectors in our dynamic region. The Outsized Impact of MSJC

MSJC's purpose is to provide an accessible education, instill hope, and empower our students to transform their lives and those around them. We provide equity-minded education to combat systemic barriers, promote social mobility, and provide opportunities for educational advancement.

Evidence of MSJC's impacts in transforming learners, transforming lives, and transforming communities is evident almost everywhere you look throughout the College District. Thousands of MSJC graduates each year and a base of alumni numbering more than 125,000 people living and working in Southwest Riverside County comprise a large portion of the regional workforce. They are our nurses, computer technicians, teachers, auto technicians, culinary workers, firefighters, digital content experts, police officers, laboratory workers, entrepreneurs, and so much more.

Included in the student body are more than 1,400 military veterans who completed their service to our country and now are facing the significant challenge of transitioning into the local workforce. Every year MSJC helps launch more than 140 highly-trained military veteran graduates back into our economy with the tools they need to succeed in well-paying jobs.

Community colleges like MSJC yield an outsized impact on workforce development and the regional economy but receive only a fraction of the per-student state financial support compared to universities.

Most people don't realize that MSJC is not fully state-supported but rather state-assisted. A portion of every dollar budgeted must be generated from off-campus resources for the College to deliver on its important mission.

Designated as a Hispanic-Serving Institution since 2001 based on more than 50% of our students identifying as Latinx, we serve a diverse student population from various identities, cultures, socioeconomic backgrounds, life experiences, abilities, and educational needs that represent our community. MSJC is committed to learning and achievement through inclusive and culturally affirming environments that celebrate student voices and create space for self-exploration and growth. We encourage self-advocacy, civic responsibility, and commitment to becoming ambassadors of change in our communities and our world.


